Automotive fluids (antifreeze, used motor oil), corrosives, all types of batteries, fluorescent lights & chemical ballasts, mercury thermometers, unused or outdated prescription medications (no controlled substances or sharps & needles), compressed gas cylinders, oil-based paint & stains, toxic garden supplies, poisons & miscellaneous toxic household products; self-hauled materials only.

## WHAT'S NOT ACCEPTED:

Business or farm waste, government agency or non-profit waste, electronic waste, used tires, used cooking oil, explosives, pyrophorics, flares & water reactive materials, biological or infectious waste, radioactive & shock sensitive materials, fire extinguishers, detergents & non-hazardous materials
