DIRECTIONS TO COUNTY OF HAWAI'I SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING FACILITIES

<p><u>East Hawai'i Organics Facility</u></p>	<p>Heading south on Highway 11 take the first left past the airport intersection onto Leilani St. Continue on Leilani/Ho'olaulima for approximately 2.0 miles.</p> <p>East Hawai'i Organics Facility @ 1642 Ho'olaulima Rd.</p>
<p><u>East Hawai'i Regional Sort Station</u></p>	<p>Heading south on Highway 11 toward Volcano take the first left past the airport intersection onto Leilani Street. Continue on Leilani/Ho'olaulima for approximately 2.5 miles.</p> <p>East Hawai'i Regional Sort Station @ 1651 Ho'olaulima Rd.</p>
<p><u>Glenwood Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Volcano)</p>	<p>Take a right off of Hwy 11 at the 17-mile marker.</p>
<p><u>Hawaiian Ocean View Estates Convenience Center</u> Directions (coming from Kona)</p>	<p>Heading south on Highway 11, turn left between 77 & 76-mile markers onto Donala Dr. Take left onto Paradise Pkwy, then left fork of road onto Paradise Circle Makai. Near intersection with Keaka Pkwy.</p>
<p><u>Hilo Recycling & Transfer Station, Scrap Metal Yard, East Hawai'i Organics Facility, South Hilo Sanitary Landfill and Solid Waste Baseyard</u></p>	<p>Heading south on Highway 11 toward Volcano take the first left past the airport intersection onto Leilani Street. Continue on Leilani for approximately 1.5 miles.</p> <p>Hilo Recycling & Transfer Station @ 1471 Ho'olaulima Rd. Hilo RTS HI-5 Certified Redemption Center @ 1390 Ho'olaulima Rd. East Hawai'i Organics Facility @ 1642 Ho'olaulima Rd. South Hilo Sanitary Landfill Scalehouse @ 1665 Ho'olaulima Rd.</p>
<p><u>Honoka'a Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Hilo)</p>	<p>Right-hand turn off HWY 19 onto Plumeria Road. Recycling & Transfer Station is first left-hand turn</p>
<p><u>Honomū Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Hilo)</p>	<p>½ mile past 'Akaka Falls turnoff. Left turn just before the 14-mile marker. Turn right at intersection, follow to chute</p>
<p><u>Ka'auhuhu (Hāwī) Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Hāwī Town)</p>	<p>Left off of HWY 250. Left on Kynnersley Road; Take first left. Recycling & Transfer Station on right</p>
<p><u>Kailua-Kona Recycling & Transfer Station, Greenwaste Mulch Pick-up Area (a.k.a. Kealakehe Recycling & Transfer Station) & Solid Waste Baseyard</u> Directions (coming from Waimea)</p>	<p>Turn mauka on Hale Māka'i Place (1st main left past Honokōhau Marina, between 98 and 99-mile marker). Recycling & Transfer Station sign at intersection</p> <p>Kealakehe Transfer Station @ 74-626 Hale Māka'i Place Kealakehe Recycling Center @ 74-625 Hale Māka'i Place</p>
<p><u>Kalapana Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (from end of Pāhoa-Kalapana Rd.)</p>	<p>North on Highway 137 (a.k.a. Red Road or Kapoho-Kalapana Rd) and on left-hand side between 21 and 22-mile markers.</p>

<p><u>Kea'au Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Pāhoa)</p>	<p>Route 130 between 2 and 3-mile marker, on right-hand side.</p> <p>Kea'au Recycling & Transfer Station @ 16-921 Kea'au-Pāhoa Road.</p>
<p><u>Keauhou Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Kailua-Kona)</p>	<p>On Highway 11, make turnoff onto Māmalahoa Hwy just before Shell Station and Teshima's restaurant. Drive ¾ mile. Green sign on left-hand side</p>
<p><u>Ke'ei Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions: (From Kailua-Kona)</p>	<p>Take Nāpo'opo'o Road for 1 ¼ mile. Right on (new) Nāpo'opo'o Road to end; Left on Pu'uuhonua Road, for ¾ mile. Turn left at green sign (4 miles total)</p>
<p><u>Laupāhoehoe Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (going toward Honoka'a)</p>	<p>Left-hand turn off Highway 19 (just before 25 mile marker) Turn left again and go ¼ mile to end of road. Recycling & Transfer Station on the right.</p>
<p><u>Miloli'i Transfer Station</u> Directions (From Hawai'i Belt Road)</p>	<p>Take Miloli'i Road toward the village. Transfer Station at the base of the bottom road, on the right side of the road</p>
<p><u>Pa'auilo Transfer Station</u> Directions (going toward Honoka'a)</p>	<p>Left turn at 37-mile marker</p>
<p><u>Pāhala Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Nā'ālehu)</p>	<p>Take a left off of Hwy 11 onto Maile Rd, between 53 & 52-mile marker</p>
<p><u>Pāhoa Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (from old Pāhoa Town)</p>	<p>Take Apa'a Road for 0.7 miles; Recycling & Transfer Station is on right side</p>
<p><u>Pāpa'ikou Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Hilo)</p>	<p>The first left after the 6-mile marker, take first right and proceed ¼ mile. Turn left into Recycling & Transfer Station.</p>
<p><u>Puakō Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Waimea)</p>	<p>From Queen Ka'ahumanu Highway, turn right onto Puakō Beach Drive between 70 and 71-mile markers. Go ½ mile down; first left</p>
<p><u>Pu'uanahulu Landfill (a.k.a. West Hawai'i Sanitary Landfill) and West Hawai'i Organics Facility</u></p>	<p>Between the 77 & 78-mile markers on Queen Ka'ahumanu Highway. Turn mauka on Pu'u Pōhaku Road.</p>
<p><u>Volcano Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Nā'ālehu)</p>	<p>Only left turn between the 25 and 24-mile markers</p>
<p><u>Waiea Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Kailua-Kona)</p>	<p>On the right-hand side, between the 100 and 99-mile markers</p>

<p><u>Waimea Recycling & Transfer Station and Solid Waste Base Yard</u> Directions (going to Kawaihae)</p>	<p>1.5 miles from Waimea town; left turn just before 59-mile marker</p>
<p><u>Wai'ōhinu Recycling & Transfer Station</u> Directions (coming from Kailua-Kona)</p>	<p>Make a right turn just before mile marker 66 (where road cuts VERY sharp to the left). At the end of Kaulia Rd.</p>
<p><u>West Hawai'i Organics Facility</u></p>	<p>Between the 77 & 78-mile markers on Queen Ka'ahumanu Highway. Turn mauka on Pu'u Pōhaku Road.</p>
