CHANGES TO TRANSFER STATION & RECYCLING OPERATIONS, EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, MAY 1, 2020

RESIDENTIAL LOAD RESTRICTIONS AT TRANSFER STATIONS, eff. May 1, 2020:

- LOAD RESTRICTIONS
 - Maximum 1 (residential) load PER DAY and
 - Maximum 3 cubic yards of trash per load
 - 3 cubic yards is the equivalent of a full-sized pickup truck with an 8foot bed filled up to the side rails
 - Note: Businesses cannot use the transfer stations, and must use the East Hawai'i Sanitary Landfill (Hilo) or West Hawai'i Sanitary Landfill (Waikoloa)

RECYCLING HOURS AT COUNTY TRANSFER STATIONS:

Collection of recyclables will be from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., eff. May 1, 2020.

COLLECTION OF GREENWASTE IS POSTPONED

 The Division will notify the public when greenwaste collection at Hāwī, Honoka'a and Keauhou Transfer Stations will be implemented, once the restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic have been lifted.
