## LOAD SIZE RESTRICTION AT EAST HAWAI'I REGIONAL SORT STATION CONTINUES THROUGH SUNDAY, MAY 31, 2020

• Businesses hauling commercially generated wastes in quantities greater than five (5) cubic yards continue to be restricted from using the sort station

**East Hawai'i Regional Sort Station** services are closed to businesses hauling <u>commercially</u> generated wastes larger than five (5) cubic yards until at least May 31, 2020. A five cubic yard load will fit in a standard size pickup truck with an 8-foot long bed filled up to the top of the cab.

The Sort Station, located at the South Hilo Sanitary Landfill (a.k.a. Hilo Dump), will continue to accept businesses hauling *residentially* generated waste loads of less than five (5) cubic yards during regular business hours from 7:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. (closed 12:00 p.m. to 12:30 p.m.) daily.

The County of Hawaii's Department of Environmental Management is taking these measures to prioritize household trash and to ensure families staying at home during this COVID-19 crisis are able to dispose of their household trash each and every day.
