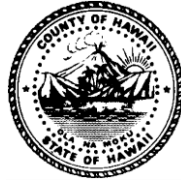

Service Restrictions at the Solid Waste Transfer Stations are Continuing Until Further Notice

Due to COVID-19 concerns, the Solid Waste Division is continuing to suspend the following programs and services:

Electronic Device Recycling Collection.

Greenwaste Collection is suspended at Kea'au and Volcano Transfer Stations, but continues to be offered at:

East Hawai'i Organics Facility, 7:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. daily (7 days a week)
West Hawai'i Organics Facility, 7:00 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Monday through Saturday
Kealakehe, Waimea, and Pāhoa Transfer Stations: 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday, Wednesday, and Saturday
Ke'ei Transfer Station: 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday, Tuesday, and Friday

Scrap Metal and White Goods Collection is suspended at **all** county transfer stations. Please visit <https://www.hawaiizerowaste.org/recycle/scrap-metal/> for a list of other metal recyclers.
