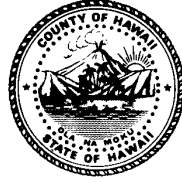

Temporary closure for Monday, August 30, 2021: Volcano Transfer Station *and* White Goods and Scrap Metal Services in East Hawai'i

The County of Hawai'i Department of Environmental Management, Solid Waste Division, announces the temporary closure of the Volcano Transfer Station on Monday, August 30, 2021. The White Goods and Scrap Metal Services in East Hawai'i (at the Volcano, Kea'au, Pāhoa, and Hilo transfer stations) are also unavailable. The Volcano Transfer Station is scheduled to reopen on Thursday, September 2, 2021.

Residents in the Volcano Community may take their household-generated waste to the Hilo Transfer Station, Kea'au Transfer Station, or the Pāhoa Transfer Station. These alternate facilities will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
