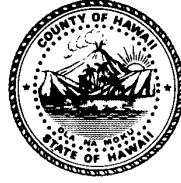

## **Greenwaste Service for Residential Users is Reopening at Select Locations, Effective Saturday, May 9, 2020**

**Greenwaste service for residential users will be available three days a week at the following locations, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., starting this Saturday, May 9<sup>th</sup>:**

- **Pāhoa Transfer Station:** Saturdays, Sundays, and Wednesdays
- **Ke'ei Transfer Station:** Sundays, Tuesdays, and Fridays
- **Waimea Transfer Station:** Saturdays, Sundays, and Wednesdays

### **Greenwaste service requirements are:**

A maximum of 1 residential load **per day** and 5 cubic yards per load. 5 cubic yards is the equivalent of a full-sized pickup truck with an 8-foot bed filled up to the cab.

Users must keep a 6 ft. or greater 'social distance' from each other and facility employees. If a 6 ft. 'social distance' cannot be maintained, **all users must wear a cloth face covering.**

Anyone with symptoms of the COVID-19 virus will be restricted from using the services at these facilities.
