

Notice of Proposed Amendment to the Rules of Practice and Procedure
of the Department of Environmental Management

The County of Hawai‘i Department of Environmental Management, pursuant to Section 91-3 of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes, and DEM Rule No. 3-2, hereby provides notice of its intent to amend the following:

- Rule No. 5-3, adding a definition of an “unsecured load.”
- Rule No. 9-17, relating to vehicles and trailers that may be allowed at certain solid waste transfer stations.
- Rule No. 12-3, adding a residential credit for commercial haulers of residential waste.
